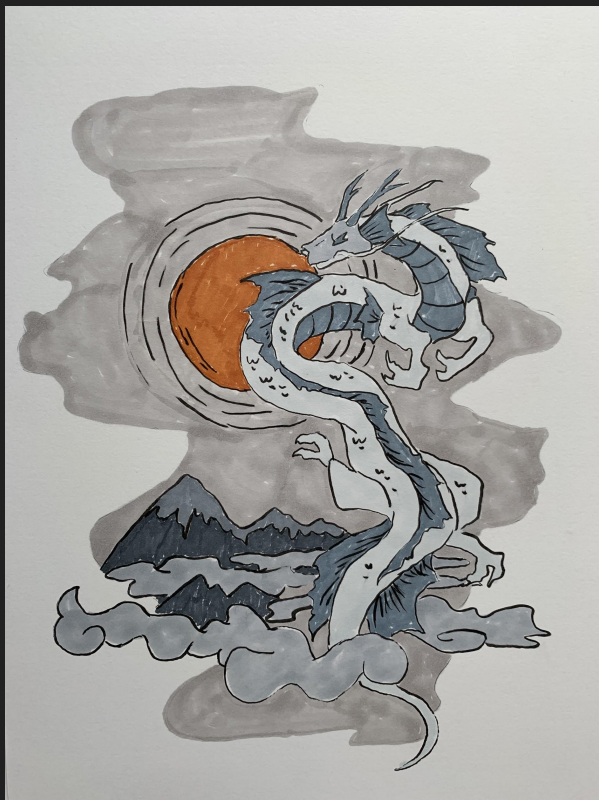
About Me

Why I am an artist:

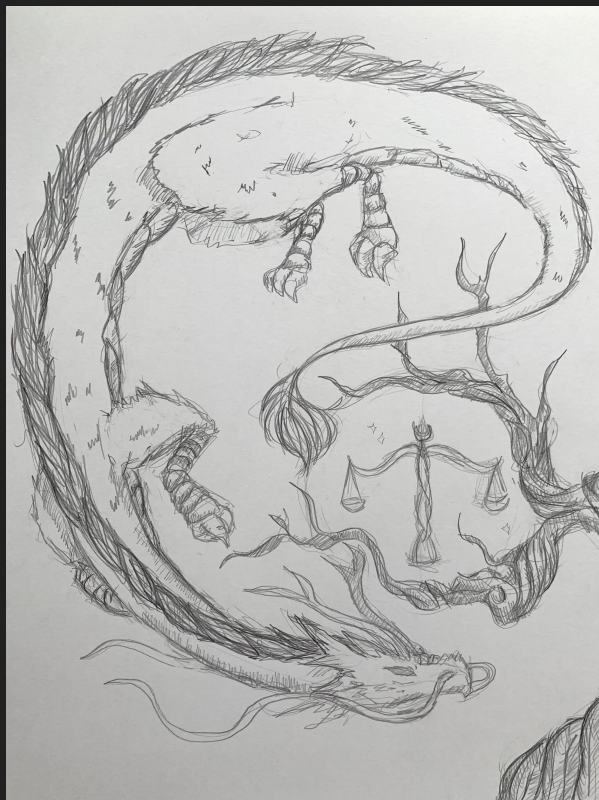

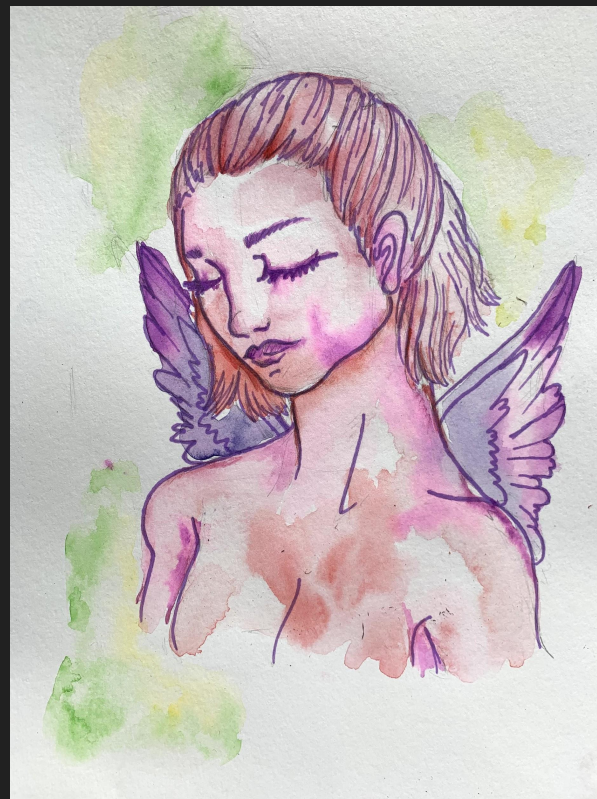


Series 2: Tarot Dragons (Each Panel is 11" x 14"- Graphite on Paper)

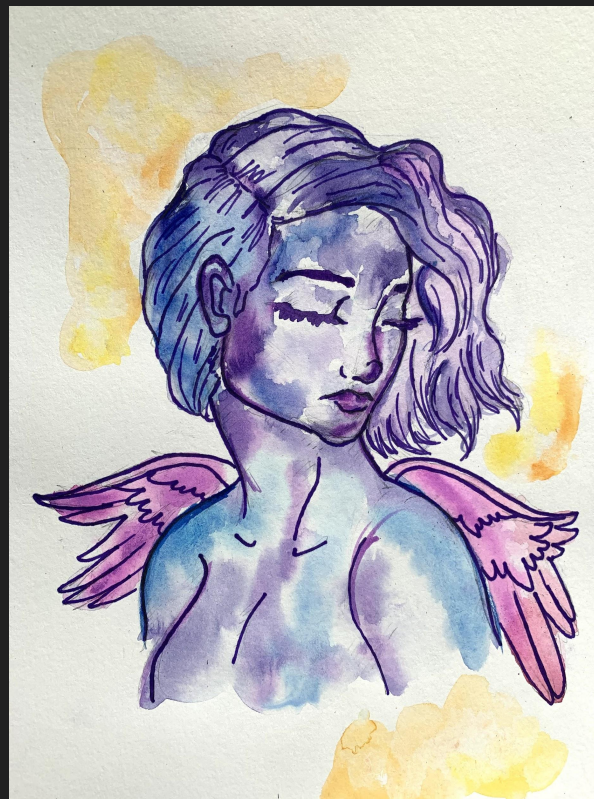
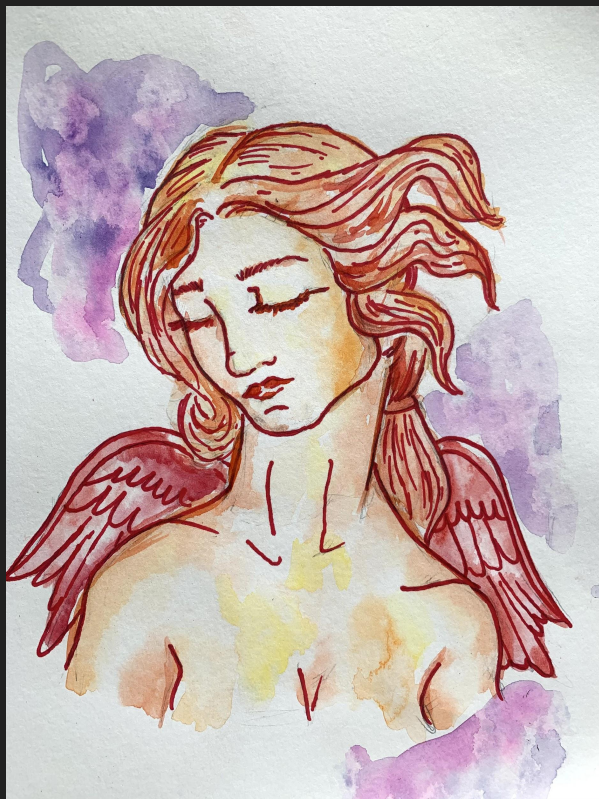


Series 3: Watercolor Angels

Series 4: Tarot Angels (Each Panel is 11" x 14"- Colored Pencil and Micron Pen on Paper)



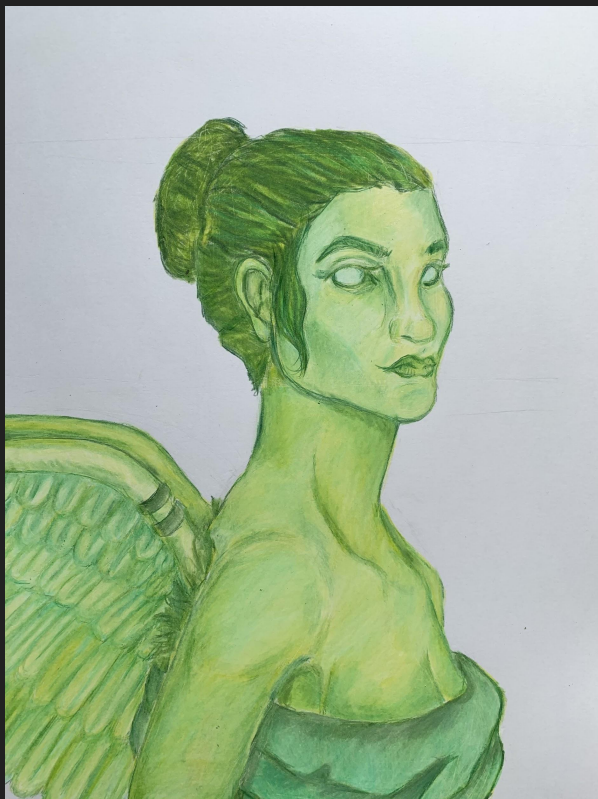
